VIII. ADDENDUM

GCAT – Global Champions Arabian Tour – Rules for Affiliation of Shows

1. World Championship, Title and A shows included in the GCAT

- already existing World Championship, Title and A shows, included in the GCAT, follow their own BB rules and procedures for affiliation of shows
- affiliation fees of already existing World Championship, Title and A shows, included in the GCAT, are set by the Rules for Affiliation of Shows

2. Other shows included in the GCAT

- affiliation of other GCAT shows has to follow Procedure of Affiliation priorities of ECAHO Shows / Stage A preliminary calendar (until the 31st of January)
- other shows, being included in the GCAT by the SC approval, should receive the status of GCAT Show
- other show, being approved as GCAT Shows should follow the Rules for Affiliation of Shows / A Shows
- affiliation fee for other GCAT Shows: € 3000,-

3. Qualifications for GCAT Shows:

All horses except yearlings should have qualified at an ECAHO affiliated show in one of the following ways:

- 1) ECAHO affiliated Shows:
 - 1st to 5th place at the World Championship, Title, A, GCAT or B Show
 - 1st to 3rd place at National Championship, C International or European Show
 - 1st place at a Specific Origin or C National Show

2) non-ECAHO countries:

- Champion or Reserve Champion or top 10 at the US Nationals
- Champion or Reserve Champion or a 1st place in class at the Scottsdale Show (US)
- Champion or Reserve Champion in Regional Shows (US)
- 1st 3rd place at the Arabian Breeders World Cup show (US)
- Champion or Reserve Champion, or 1st to 3rd place in an official National Championship show

4. <u>4. Prize-money percentage</u>

3% contribution from the total prize money rewards, paid out at GCAT Shows, is counted only from individual shows. The GCAT Overall Ranking rewards and Bonuses are not subject to 3 % contribution from the prize money.
